

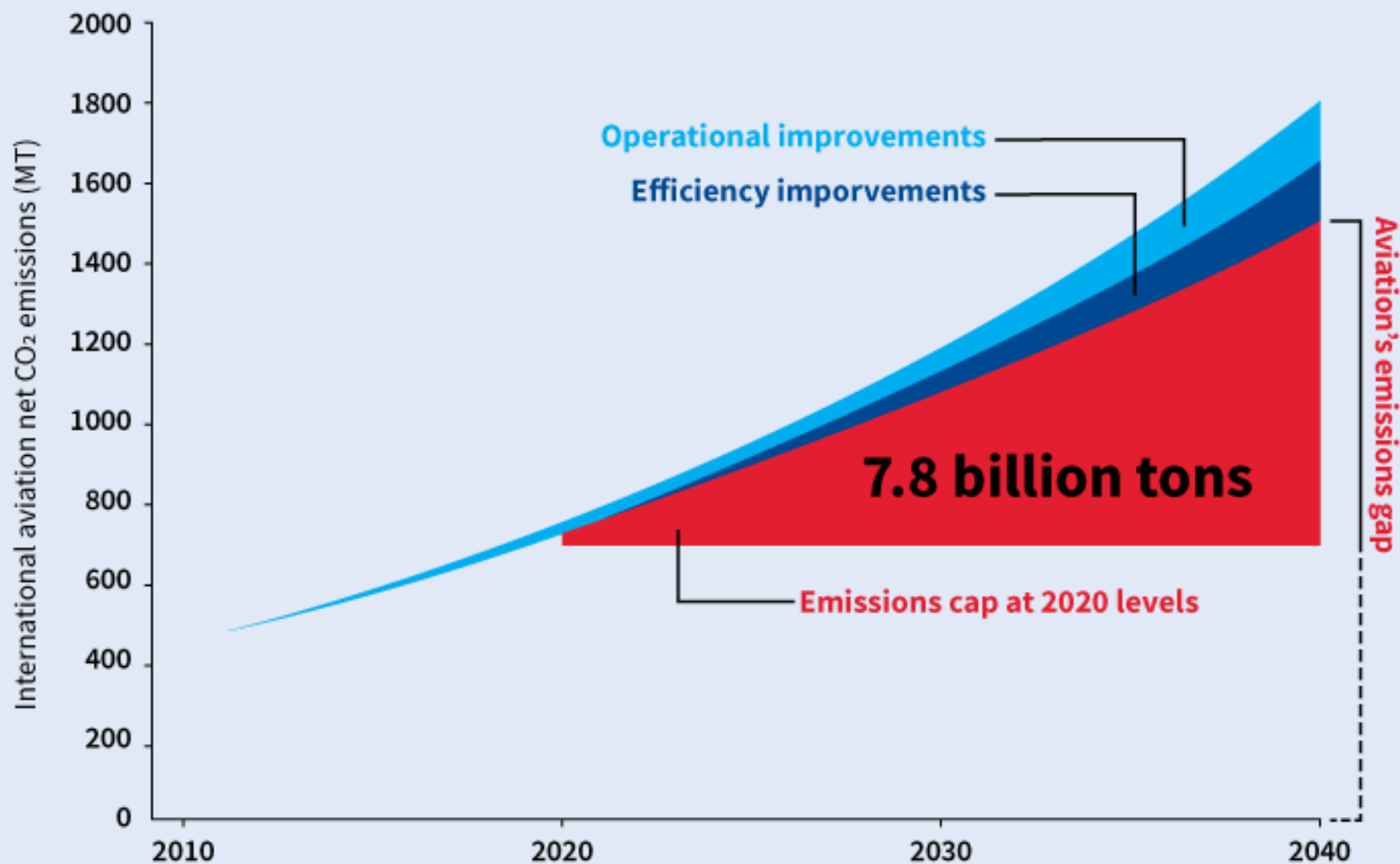

WHAT IS CORSIA?

- Carbon Offset and Reduction Scheme for International Aviation
- Pilot phase (2021-2023) and first phase (2024-2026) both voluntary. Mandatory 2027-2035.
- **68 States**, representing more than **75%** of international aviation emissions have signed up
- Exemptions for LDCs, SIDS, LLDCs and operators below 10,000MT CO₂
- Airlines required to offset growth above 2020 levels, can get credit for alternative fuel use

21.6%

CORSIA's weak plan will offset only 21.6% of global emissions between 2021-2035

- Expand participation to close the 2020 emissions gap
- Finalise and implement criteria for EUC, MRV and registries through CAEP’s GMTF
- Identify effective enforcement means
- Support states, especially developing states, in implementing CORSIA
