Dear Ms. Filzmoser,

Thank you for your letter to the CDM Executive Board dated 8 July 2010, which has been made available to the Board. Please accept our apologies for the delay in sending you the response.

On behalf of the Chair of the Board, I thank you and assure you that your request regarding the the above mentioned subject has been appropriately considered. In this context, I am glad to inform you that the Board, in its 58<sup>th</sup> meeting, considered the outcome of the work undertaken by the Meth Panel on HCFC22 production and HFC23 generation as related to methodology AM0001 and requested the Meth Panel to revise the methodology. The executive summary of the report from the Meth panel regarding this issue is contained in the annex 11 of EB58 meeting report (<https://cdm.unfccc.int/EB/index.html>). The Board further agreed to put the methodology AM0001 on hold with immediate effect. The Board also requested the Meth Panel to consider the extent of revision of the methodology AM0001 based on the shortcomings identified in their analysis, and report to the Board at its sixty-first meeting (Ref.: paragraph 28 of EB58 meeting report).

In addition to the above, the request for renewal of crediting period of the project activity "HFC Decomposition Project in Ulsan" (0003) has been placed under review by the Board and is expected to be considered by the board in its 59<sup>th</sup> meeting.
