International Level (UNFCCC)

- Expose deficiencies of the CDM
- •Influence the political process (UNFCCC, CDM EB, etc...)

- Influence European governments and companies not to buy credits from harmful projects
- Influence the legislative process

Public Comments - Checklist

DNA letter of approval

Has your DNA approved this project?

Public consultation

Were you consulted by the project developer?

Does the summary in the PDD accurately reflect what you said and does it adress the concerns you had?

EIA

Was the EIA carried out according to national laws and standards?

Additionality

Will this project go ahead anyway if it is not registerd as CDM project

Has the project already begun? Construction works etc..?

Baseline: accurate and credible estimation of what will happen in the absence of the project being registered as a CDM project?



Does the project contribute to sustainable development in your country?

Were you consulted by the project developer?

VVM


Research & draft comment – need to focus on the violation of CDM rules (additionality, local stakeholder consultation, etc..)

Submission in English, trough online system

Deadline: 24h GMT on last day



Next steps:




Prepare for publication of validation report (-1 year) – comments must be taken into account – project can only be validated if DOE can prove that project complies with rules despite your claims!

Contact DNA to be kept informed about new projects being developed





Summary of tools

Project develop ment

- The project developer has to inform and consult about the project
- · Request the government to inform CSO about planned projects

EIA

• Ev. possibility to have a say – advocate for stronger public consultation!

Aproval by DNA

- CSO needs to be consulted have you got a say on the board of the DNA?
- · Public pressure if project has negative impacts compared to bau

Validation

- Raise issues during 30 day public commenting period public!
- · Launch complaint procedure against misconduct by DOE

Requesting registration

· Lobby for request of a review - might lead to project rejection!

verification & monitoring

 Try to lobby for a review of the request for issuance to avoid emission of credits

After credits have been issued

 Public pressure against credits from harmful projects or project types (Black-list)



Obstacles and need for action!

Public participation rules weak and unclear

 + CSO often do not know its rights or does not use them

No notification

Need for mailserve / info through DNA?

English only

 Possibility to submit complaints in host country language needed – to whom?

Public commenting period 30 days only

Too short to inform potentially impacted people and analyse project

no appeal against registered projects possible

 Need for way to adress negative impacts and complaints

Sustainable development is defined by host government

- Intervene at early stage DNA level!
- Later project can only be rejected if it violates CDM rules at UN level
