

What Role can Civil Society play BEYOND Stakeholder Consultations?

CDM DOES NOT REDUCE EMISSIONS!

BUT

UNFCCC / KP

- NO CDM without KP – NO offsets without binding targets
- CDM must be connected to high reduction targets
- CDM only supplementary to very high localised reduction targets (eg. 40%)

What Role can Civil Society play BEYOND Stakeholder Consultations?

Reduce -ve impacts of CDM project implementation

- **Stronger rules on Local Stakeholder Consultations**
- **Strictly adhere to FPIC (Free Prior Informed Consent)**
- **Formalise a Grievance Mechanism**

Benefit Sharing with Local People

- **Back to basics – Polluter Pays**
- **Currently only Private Entity benefits from project proceeds**
- **Taxing Project Developers / Royalties to share proceeds of CER to SD fund; (10% - 40% ??)**

What Role can Civil Society play BEYOND Stakeholder Consultations?

Strengthen Integrity of DNA

- DNA, in some cases, is promoter of CDM – remuneration & KPI achievement depending on volume/numbers of projects developed for CDM**
- Insist on CSO representation at DNA level**
- Impose International Sustainable Development Criteria**
- Improve definition and role of SD at country level**
- Review all DNA practices – Best Practice instead of Minimal Requirements**
